- Container terminal area will be separated from Multipurpose Terminal
- CTL is ready for **24/7 quay side operations**
- Gate opening hours are Monday to Friday **from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.**

Introduction: Terminal Services Portfolio



CTL will take over all container handling for full and empty containers

- at landside (truck gate) delivering / receiving
- at quayside (vessel) loading / discharging / re-stowing

CTL provides storage service for all type of ISO containers with dry cargo, temperature-controlled/refrigerated cargo and dangerous & hazardous cargo (excl. explosive and radioactive cargo) and empty containers with 3 storage days free of charge.

CTL offers reefer service as there are provision of reefer plugs/power, plugging/unplugging and reefer monitoring service.

At the beginning certain add-on services will remain unchanged, by means

- lashing/unlashing on board vessels will remain at lines vendors or vessels
- container M&R services will remain at lines vendors

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Changed tasks & responsibilities for vessel operation



Some former agents' tasks will move to CTL operations responsibility.

- Berth planning will be done by CTL through vessels announcements/coastal schedules by email/telephone on a daily basis, no more agents meetings will take place, but active communications is still appreciated
- Planning matters (stowage) will be handled by CTL staff, that means direct communications with the lines central planning departments or vessels command
- Operations are fully managed and dispatched by CTL staff, blue collar as well as white collar
- Managing of deployment of stevedores pursuant to Port Workers Law and according to the shift working program is performed by CTL
- Quay side recording activity will be managed by CTL
- In general containers should be on site 2hrs before starting load operation of the vessel
- Containers with load order must be customs cleared for export

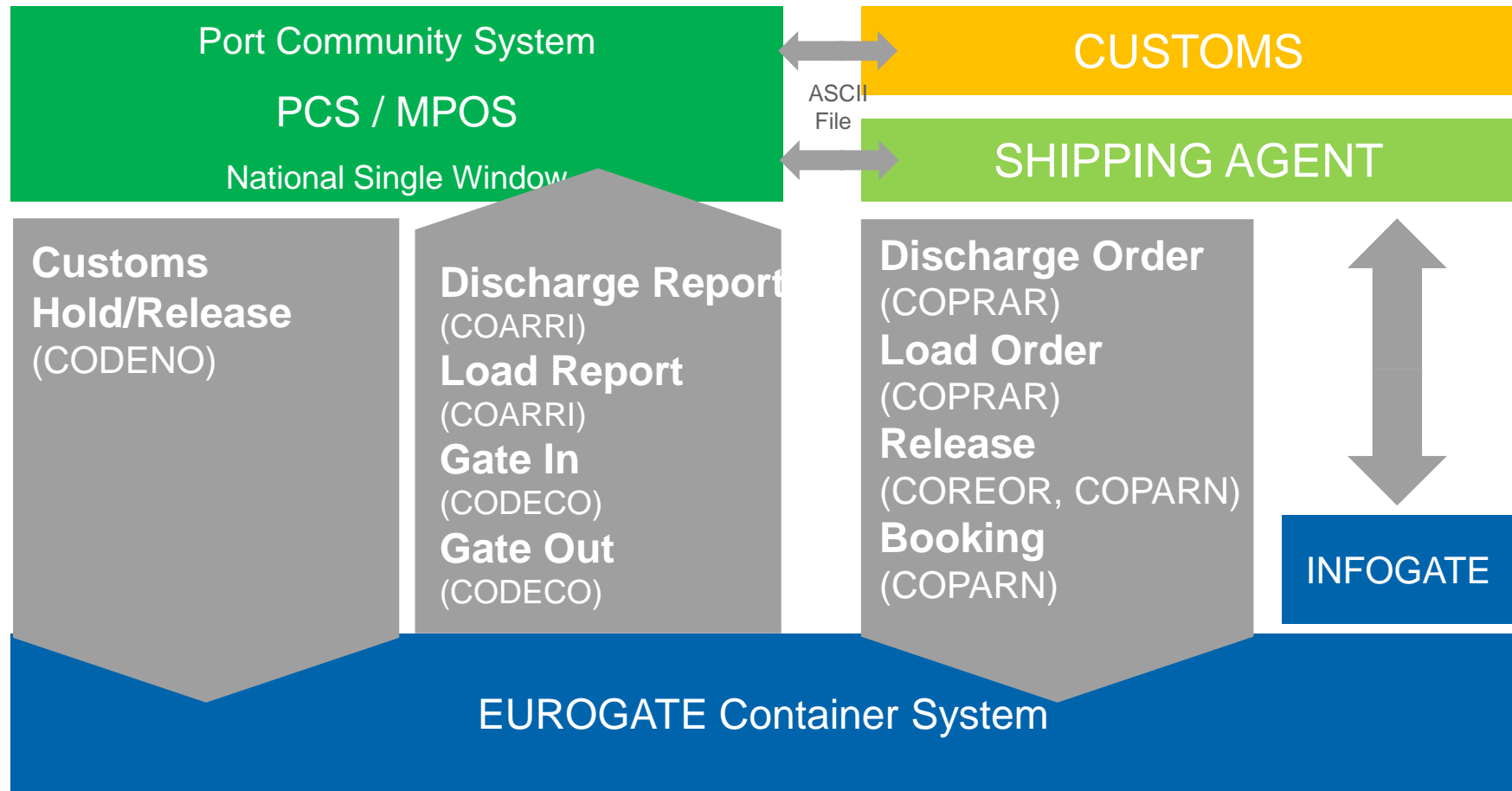
Adapted gate procedure for fast proceeding and a minimum of paperwork

- CTL will have only one registration gate (one stop for trucker)
- Due to minimal paperwork at the registration gate the truckers will require either
 - Export / booking data when bringing export containers to CTL or
 - Release order number / PIN when picking up import containers or
 - Release order number / PIN when picking up empty containers

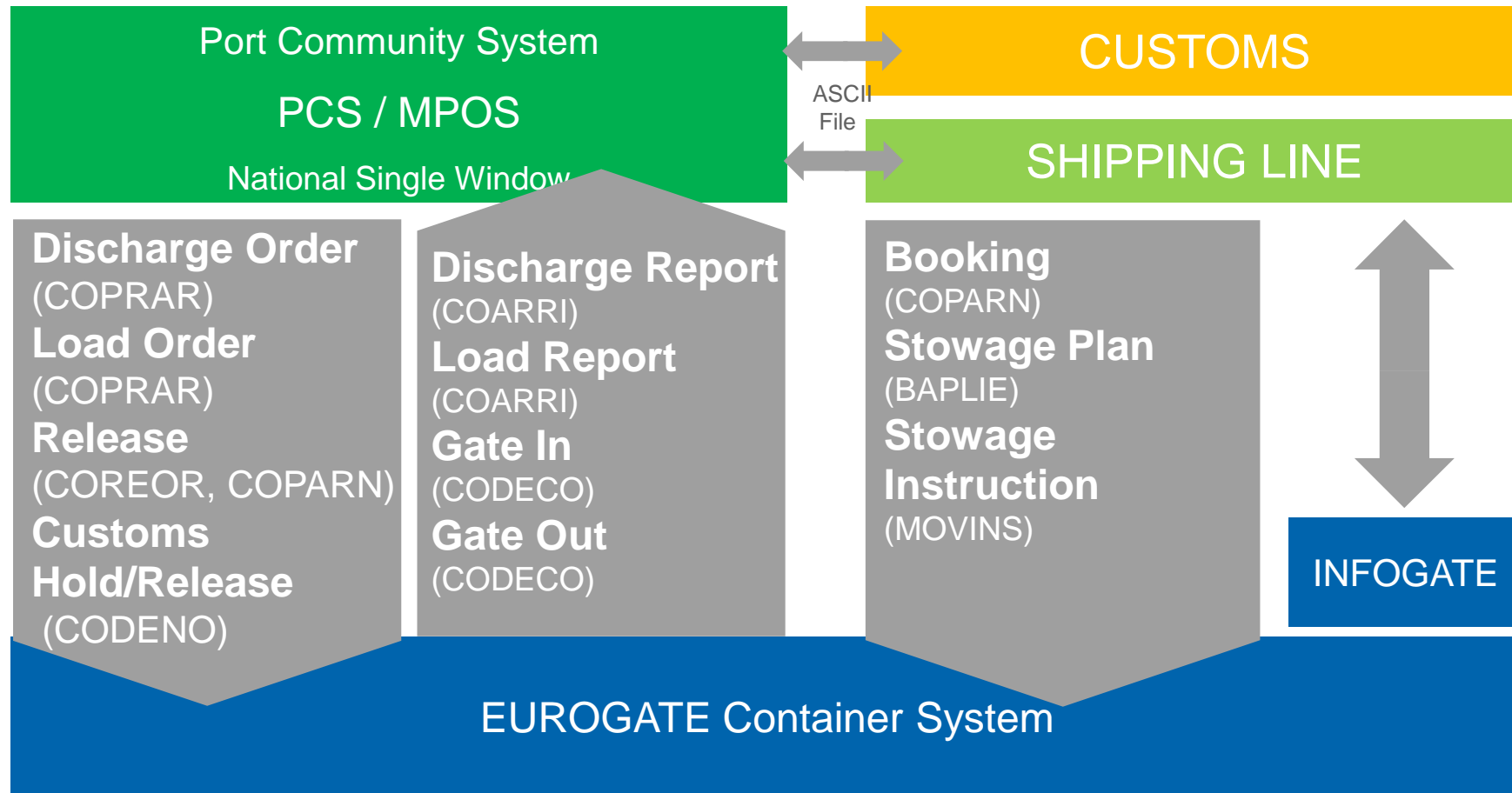
Relevant export / release data should be provided by shipping agents to trucker / forwarder and to CTL prior to truck arrival.

- Import container will only be delivered in case of matching release information
- Only customs cleared import containers will be delivered
- All applicable charges at truck gate out will be invoiced subsequently. Payments during gate procedure are not possible.

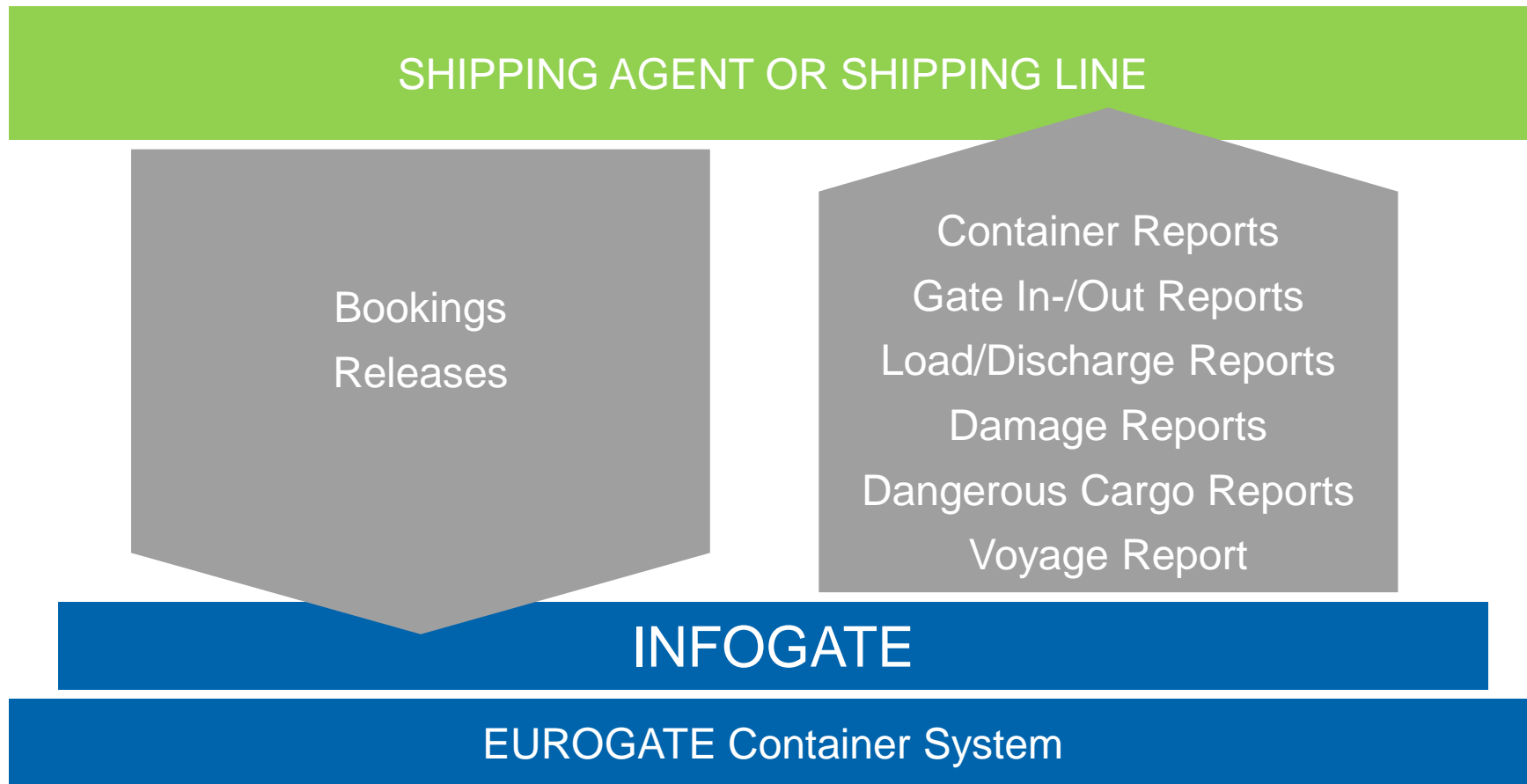
Interfaces (vessel operators)



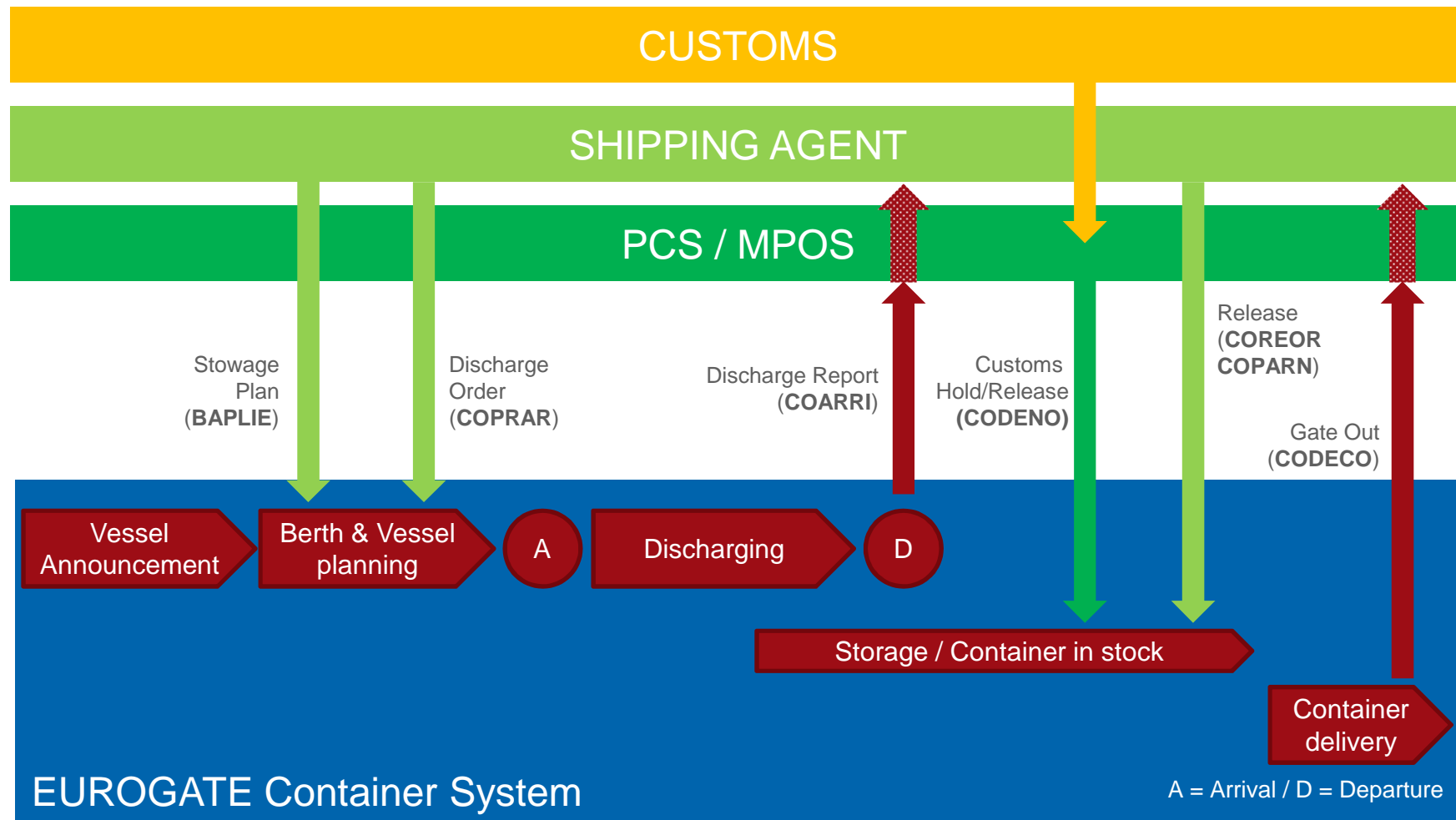

Process overview and information flow Import



Import / Transshipment

FOR DISCHARGING FROM VESSEL

➤ Bay plan

- Stowage plan of container on board (discharge and remain on board)
- Sent by shipping line / central planner via EDI (BAPLIE)
- Container stow location, POD

➤ Discharge order

- Order for container discharge
- Sent by shipping agent via EDI (COPRAR) or PCS
- Detailed information like ISO code, Dangerous Goods Declaration, OOG, Reefer, special handling codes, POD, Load Vessel

Import / Transshipment

FOR TRUCK LOADING (only import)

➤ Release Order (full/empty)

- Mandatory Gate Out Order / Delivery order prior to truck arrival
- Sent by shipping agent via EDI (COPARN,COREOR) or INFOGATE
- Release of each full / empty container for delivery along with a release order reference number / PIN (pick up legitimation for trucker)
- Empty container can be released by container number or attribute

➤ Customs Release

- Required prior to truck arrival on gate

Import / Transshipment

FOR DISCHARGING OF VESSEL

➤ Discharge report

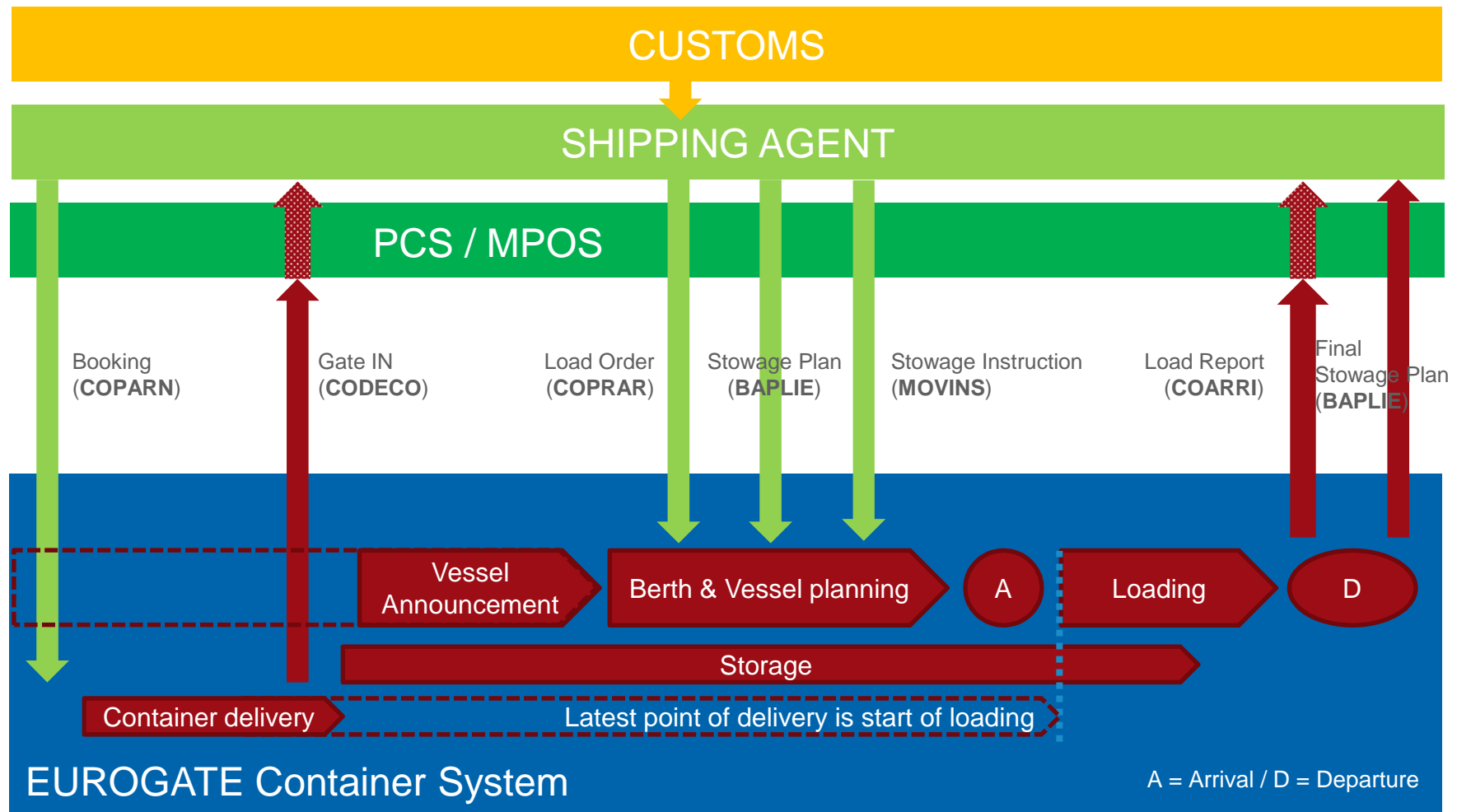
- lists all discharged containers
- Provided to shipping agent either via
 - EDI (COARRI) or Mail (Excel, PDF, CSV) or
 - INFOGATE

FOR TRUCK DELIVERY

➤ Gate Out Notification (only import)

- Lists all container delivered through gate
- Provided to shipping agent via
 - EDI (CODECO) or Mail (Excel, PDF, CSV) or
 - INFOGATE

Process overview and information flow Export



Export / Transshipment

- **Booking**, prior to container arrival (because of stowage on yard)
 - Order either (1) for Gate In for export or (2) for transshipment
 - Sent by shipping agent via EDI (COPARN) or INFOGATE
 - ISO Code, POD, Vessel of loading, Dangerous Goods Declaration, OOG, Reefer
 - Bookings are possible with or without container number
 - Booking No. should be presented by the forwarder / trucker at Gate IN
- **Load order**, prior to vessel planning
 - Order for container loading (all full ones)
 - Sent by shipping agent via EDI (COPRAR) or PCS
 - Mandatory: ISO Code, POD, Vessel of Loading, Dangerous Goods Declaration, OOG, Reefer, Verified Gross Mass (transmitted weight=VGM)
 - Load order has to arrive in time (generally 24hrs prior operation start)
 - Only customs cleared container in load order

Export / Transshipment

FOR LOADING OF VESSEL

- **Release Order** to load empty containers
 - Mandatory release order for empty container
 - Order by container number or by amount and container attribute set
 - Container attributes: ISO Code, Owner, Damage status, other as agreed

- **Stowage instruction**
 - Contains stowage instructions and fixed stow locations
 - Sent by shipping line / central planner via EDI (MOVINS)

Export / Transshipment

FOR LOADING OF VESSEL

➤ Stowage plan

- Final stowage plan of vessel after end of loading
- Sent to shipping agent / central planner via EDI (BAPLIE)
- Contains stow locations and details of loaded containers and remain on board (ROB)

➤ Load report

- Contains the list of all loaded containers
- Provided to shipping agent either via
 - EDI (COARRI) or Mail (Excel, PDF, CSV) or
 - INFOGATE

Export / Transshipment

➤ Gate In Notification

- Lists all container delivered through gate
- Sent to shipping agent via
 - EDI (CODECO) or Mail (Excel, PDF, CSV) or
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Rate Agreement and Invoicing: General information



- CTL will perform their Port Activities under **General Terms and Conditions**.
- Charges (handling, storage of full and empty containers, other) will be set out in a **Rate Agreement**.
- All charges will be invoiced via the shipping agents.
- Invoices will be issued after the respective service has been rendered.
- Invoices must be settled via bank transfers.
- Cash and cheque payments will be discontinued as of Takeover Date 29/01/2017.
